With your holiday help, we'll offer good food instead of hunger; we'll offer friendship, instead of loneliness; and we'll offer hope, instead of despair.

Easter's Festival of Hope brings resurrection's promise of new life to those whose lives seem hopeless. Following a traditional Easter service, a delicious hot meal is served, and children enjoy fun and games and Easter Baskets. Volunteers are needed to help set up for the event and to serve food.

Mother's MakeOvers helps the women of the inner city feel and look beautiful as the Mission is turned into a giant beauty salon for the day. Professional stylists, manicurists, and makeup artists are needed to help homeless and impoverished women realize how very special they are – both to God, and to us!

Thanksgiving Dinner in the Street serves a traditional turkey dinner with all the trimmings for our community's neediest individuals and families. Join us, and together we will witness the difference that love can make.

Harley Christmas Toy Ride the second Sunday of December begins with a pancake breakfast at Glendale Harley. Join thousands of bikers and bring toys to underprivileged children at the Mission. Be a **Santa – Ride a Harley**.

If you join us here on the streets, you will see more than simply men, women and little children being fed. You will see HOPE burning brightly in the eyes of little children who are always hungry. Professional and/or Skilled Volunteers Needed:

In addition to the Mission's Holiday and Community Outreach Events, a limited number of professional and/or skilled volunteers are needed periodically for other Mission events and programs throughout the year, such as:

Licensed school teachers are sometimes needed for assisting children in their homework.

Music teachers for children - - instrumental and choral.

Women's Ministries/Family Ministries - -

Computer teachers for adults.

ESL teachers for adult instruction.

Chapel Services - -

Pastors and Bible teachers.

Family Food Bags – Food Packing/Distribution

Skilled and/or licensed people in the building trades: carpenters, painters, plumbers and electricians needed for maintenance of the Mission building.

NOTE: For the children's protection the Mission will conduct thorough professional and personal background checks on anyone having contact with children.

- **JACKET DRIVES** – New or like-new clean jackets – men, women, children
- **HYGIENE ITEMS** – Toothbrushes, toothpaste, shampoo, creams & lotion
